We saw buyers from all four corners of the globe competing to secure rare Burgundy vintages from the legendary Henri Mayer. The 12 Mayer lots alone realised £902,000, with a case of Richebourg 1978 setting a world auction record of £211,500, triple the high estimate. As ever, Domaine de la Romanée Conti and Pétrus were in high demand, rounding off a memorable sale – one of the most successful wine auctions ever seen in London."
